CASE STUDY: MOTORFITS, LEVEN

Motorfits is a shop in Leven that sells motor components. The owners were keen to reduce their energy consumption, specifically from lighting and glazing. We carried out an energy audit in December 2022. This highlighted that installing LED lighting would make an annual carbon saving of 127 kgC02e and double or secondary glazing installation would save 276 KgC02e a year.





What was your experience of making energy efficiency changes?

"One recommendation from the energy audit was fitting LED lighting tubes. A local electrical firm carried out this work in one day. The lights are certainly brighter and more efficient. The energy audit also recommended double glazing in the shop. We have been successfully applied for a building improvement grant and this work will take place soon. We included our energy audit in the application.

I'd encourage any business to get the energy audit and apply for any of the grants available."
